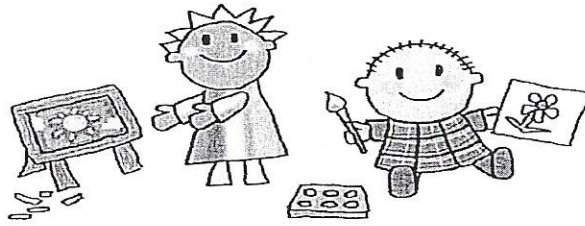
Dear Parent or Guardian:

Number & quantity matching game - on a piece of paper write numbers 1-20 and then using items from the kitchen count out a quantity and match the number.	Form the letters in your name with objects found around your house (pennies, noodles, cereal, shaving cream).	Sing ABC Song and look for items in the house that begin with the letter.	Make a card for a friend, neighbor, or someone at school	Jump 10 times Bear crawl across your living room Balance on one foot
Sort groups of toys (by color, shape, size). Say how you sorted them and then sort a different way.	Read your favorite book and identify the characters, setting, problem, and solution	Letter sound scavenger hunt- Find items in your house or yard that begins with the letters of the alphabet	Draw or paint pictures to the music, fast/slow	Make an instrument (use household item such as water in cups, beans in a toilet paper tubes, spoons on plastic cups
Create math patterns: Copy or make an AB pattern (using toys, fruit loops, manipulatives, small erasers, markers, blocks)	Listen to a story at https://www.storylineonline.net/ and retell the story.	Sing simple songs or nursery rhymes together. For song ideas search Mother Goose Club on Youtube	Draw a picture of a rainbow	Use scarves as streamers - listen to a slow beat or fast beat song and move to the rhythm
